

Appointment Type



There are 5,783 faculty teaching in NAAB-accredited degree programs: 2,320 (40%) are full-time appointments, 520 (9%) are part-time, and 2,943 (51%) are adjuncts.

The total number of faculty in 2014–15 was 5,834. The number of full-time faculty (2,320) has remained essentially the same as last year's number (2,322). The number of part-time faculty has increased by 23% over 2014–15, and the number of adjuncts has decreased by 4% over the same period.

Gender

Slight gains in the number of female faculty over 2014–15.

The gender breakdown of full- and part-time faculty (excluding adjuncts) is 1,968 (69%) males and 872 (31%) females. In 2014–15, the breakdown was 71% males and 29% females.



Of the 5,783 total faculty, 935 (16%) are full professors, 984 (17%) are associate professors, 921 (16%) are assistant professors, and 2,943 (51%) are adjuncts. The percentage distribution is similar to that of 2014–15.

Of the 5,783 total faculty (including adjuncts), 4,160 (71%) indicated white for ethnicity. The remaining categories are as follows: 21 (0%) American Indian or Alaskan Native; 407 (7%) Asian; 0 (0%) Native Hawaiian or other Pacific Islander; 161 (3%) Black or African American; 459 (8%) Hispanic; 65 (1%) two or more races; 96 (2%) nonresident alien; 412 (7%) race and ethnicity unknown.




Credentials of Full, Associate, and Assistant Professors




Faculty Salaries

National Averages

The average salary for full professors nationwide decreased by 4% from the 2014–15 average. Associate professors saw a 2% increase in average salaries, and assistant professors a 12% decrease. The average salary for instructors decreased by 11% from 2014–15.






Comparison of Salaries at Public and Private Institutions


Characteristics of the NAAB Visiting Team Pool




