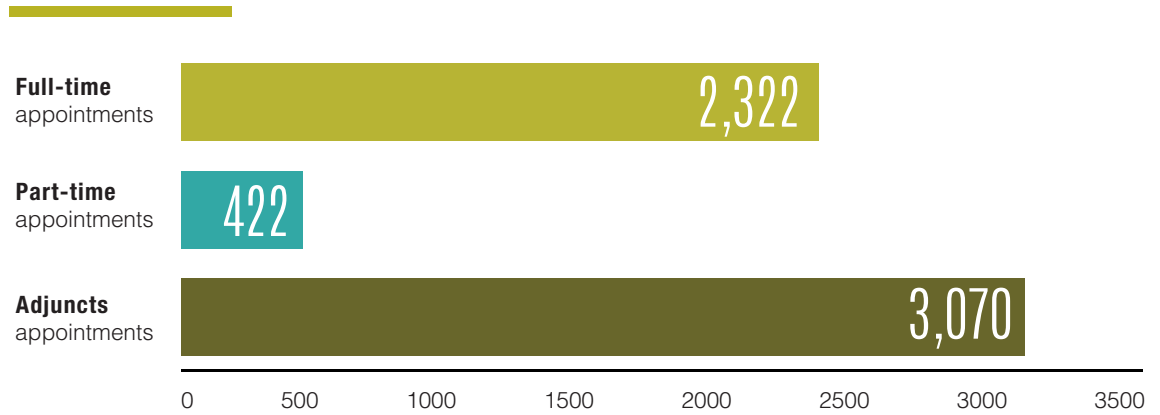

National Averages

By ACSA Region

Appointment Type

Faculty appointments increased 4% over 2013–14.



There are 5,834 faculty teaching in NAAB-accredited degree programs: 2,322 (40%) are full-time appointments, 422 (7%) are part-time, and 3,070 (53%) are adjuncts.

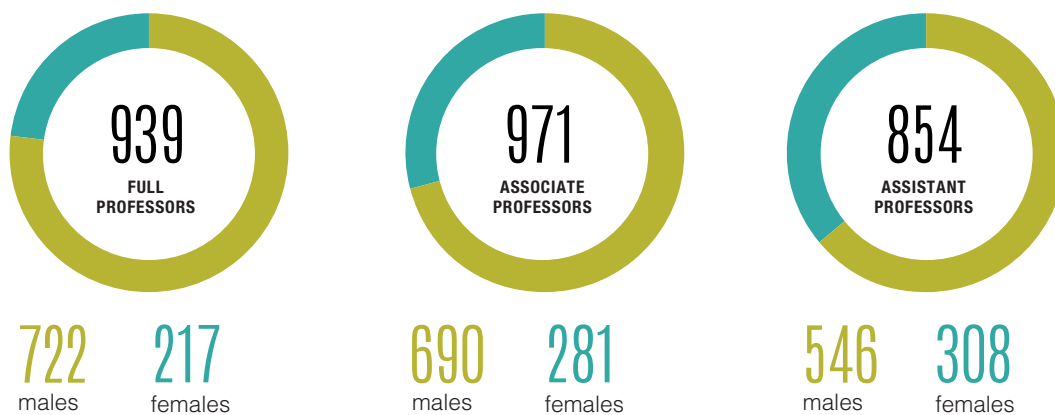
The total number of faculty has increased by 4% over last year's total (5,633). Full-time and part-time appointments have both decreased by 2 percentage points from 2013–14 levels, while the percentage of adjuncts has increased by 4 points.

Gender

No change in percentage of male/female faculty from 2013–14.

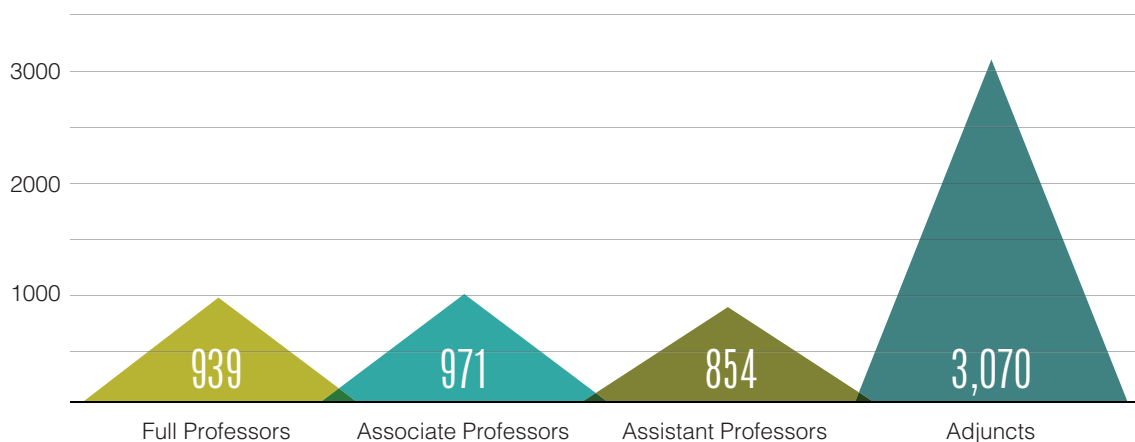
The gender breakdown of full- and part-time faculty (excluding adjuncts) is 1,958 (71%) males and 806 (29%) females. This breakdown is identical to last year's percentages.

The percentages by rank for full, associate, and assistant professors are identical to those of 2013–14.



Rank

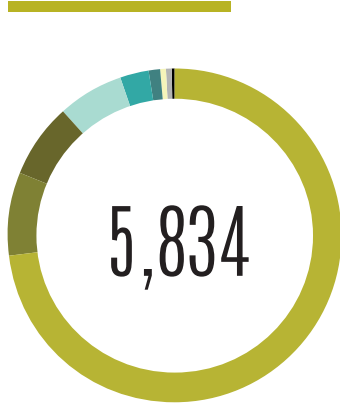
Adjuncts make up the largest bloc of faculty.



Of the 5,834 total faculty, 939 (16%) are full professors, 971 (17%) are associate professors, 854 (15%) are assistant professors, and 3,070 (52%) are adjuncts. The percentage distribution is similar to that of 2013–14.

Ethnicity

Ethnically white faculty far outnumber all other categories of ethnicity.

Of the 5,834 total faculty (including adjuncts), 4,270 (73%) indicated white for ethnicity. The remaining categories are as follows: 24 (1%) American Indian or Alaskan Native; 372 (6%) Asian; 9 (0%) Native Hawaiian or other Pacific Islander; 167 (3%) Black or African American; 475 (8%) Hispanic; 41 (1%) two or more races; 66 (1%) nonresident alien; 410 (7%) race and ethnicity unknown.

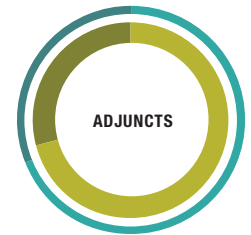

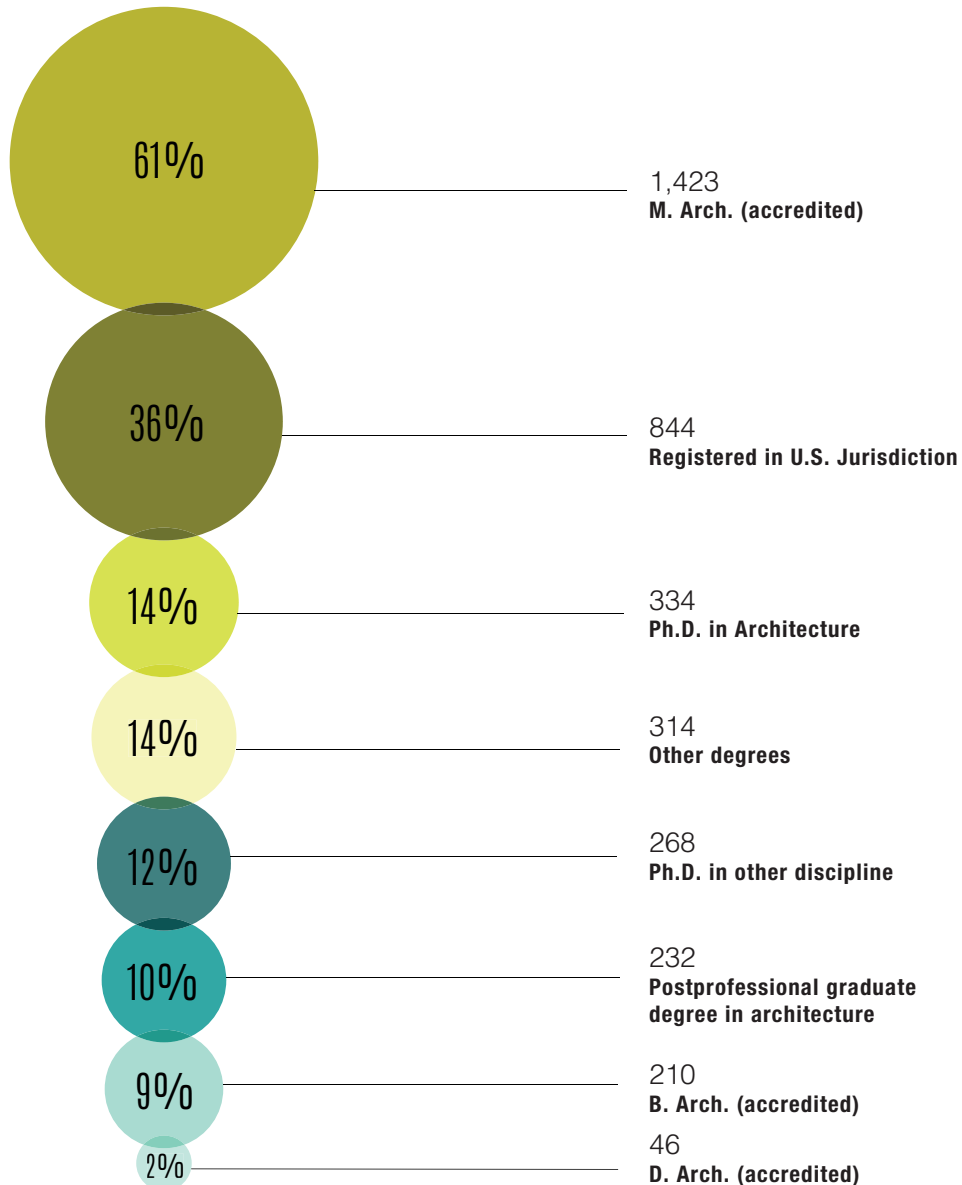

Credentials of Full, Associate, and Assistant Professors

36% of full-time faculty members are registered in a U.S. jurisdiction.

Based on data supplied by accredited architecture programs for the 2014–15 academic year, 2,322 individuals are employed as full-time instructional faculty at the full, associate, or assistant professor level.

Credentials of Full-Time Faculty (does not include adjuncts)

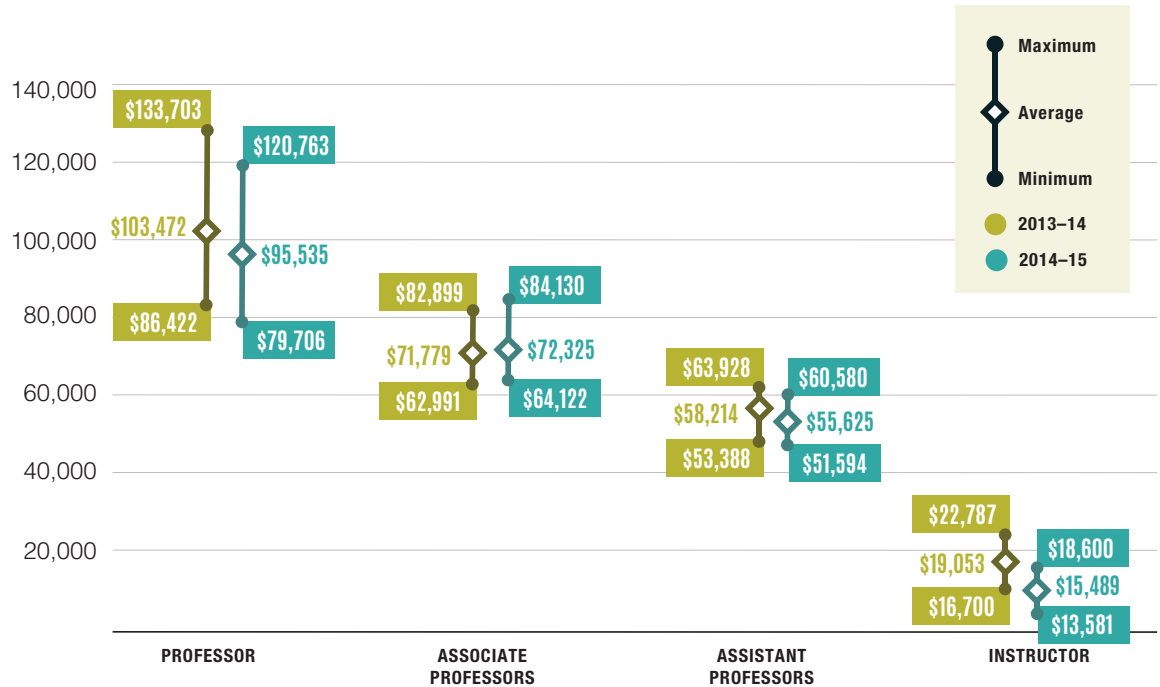


Faculty Salaries

National Averages

The average salary for full professors nationwide decreased by 8% from the 2013–14 average. Associate professors saw a 1% increase in average salaries, and assistant professors a 4% decrease. The average salary for instructors decreased by 19% from 2013–14.

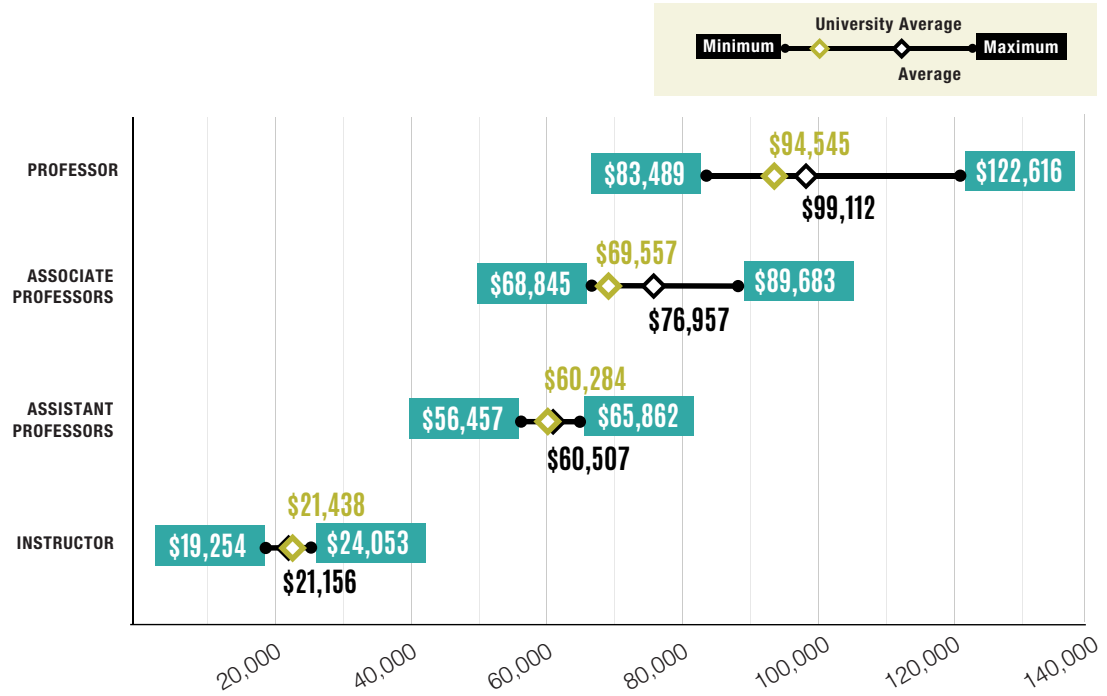

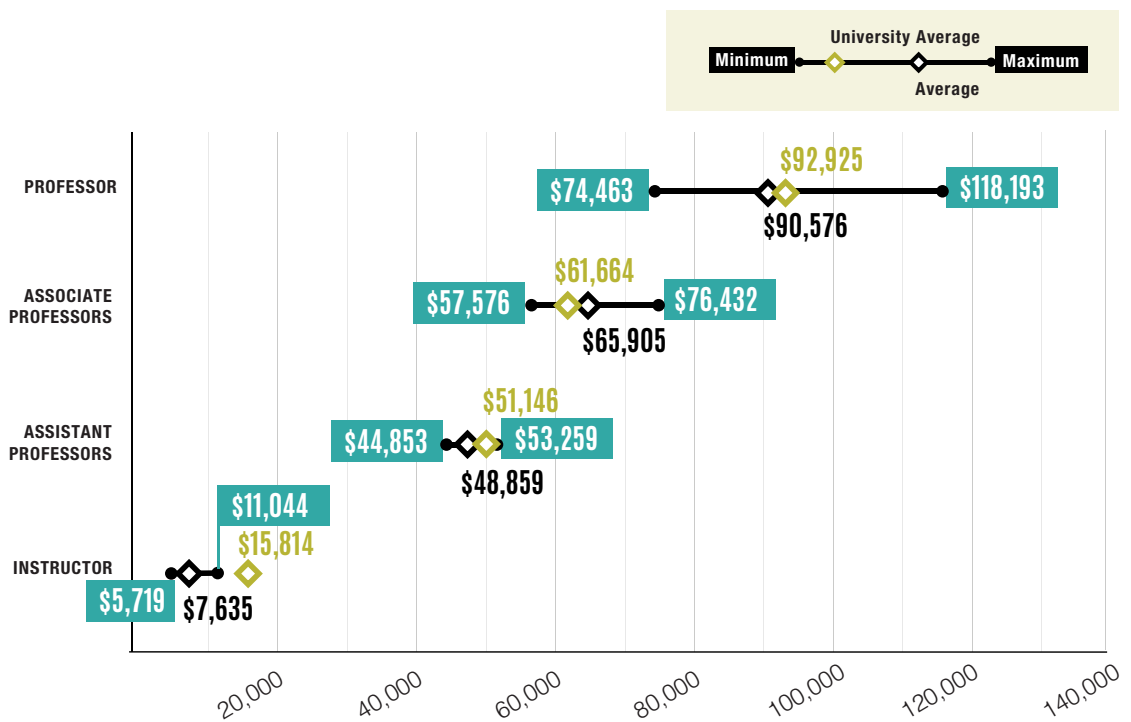
Comparing Public and Private Institutions

Generally, national averages for salaries at public institutions are higher than at private institutions. This is true not only for architecture but also for university averages.

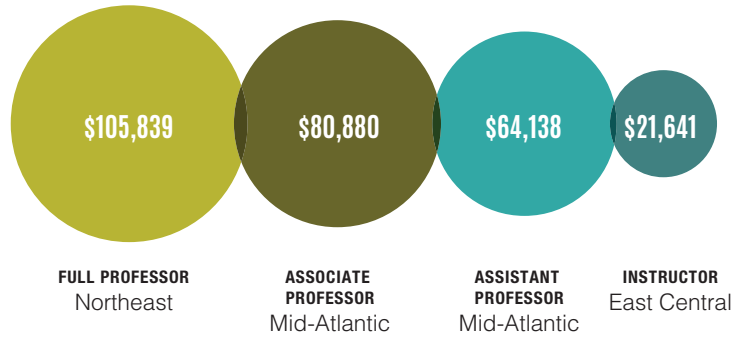
All ACSA Regions—Public
