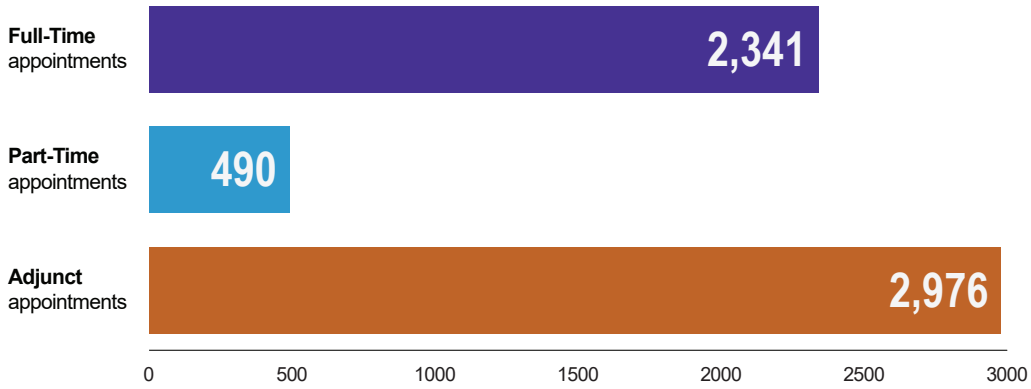

Faculty

Appointment Type



There are 5,807 faculty teaching in NAAB-accredited degree programs: 2,341 (40%) are full-time appointments, 490 (8%) are part-time, and 2,976 (51%) are adjuncts.

The total number of faculty in 2015–16 was 5,783. The number of full-time faculty (2,341) has increased slightly from last year's number (2,320). The number of part-time faculty decreased by 6% over 2015–16, and the number of adjuncts increased by 1% over the same period.

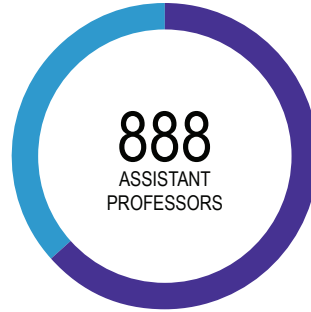

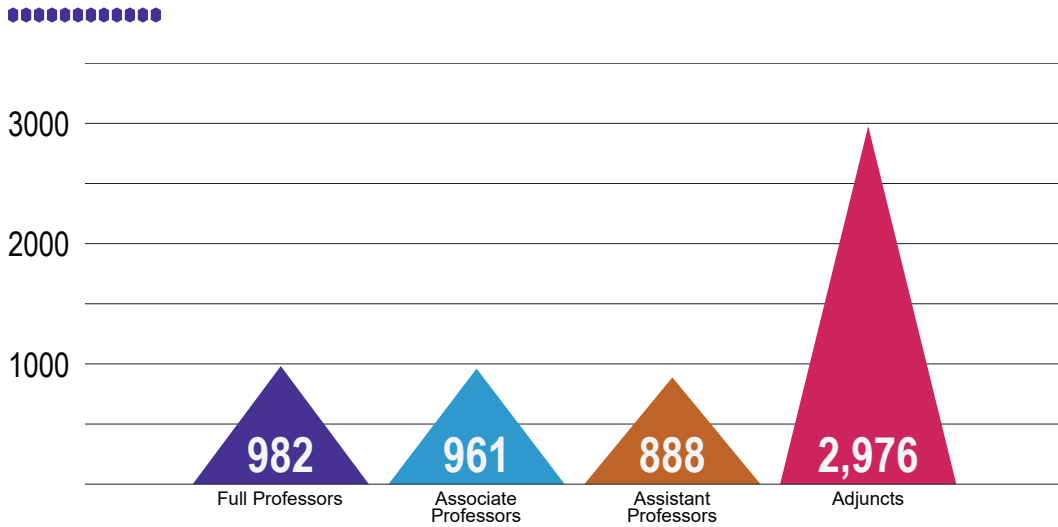

The gender breakdown of full- and part-time faculty (excluding adjuncts) is 1,953 (69%) males and 878 (31%) females. These percentages remain unchanged from 2015–16.



Rank

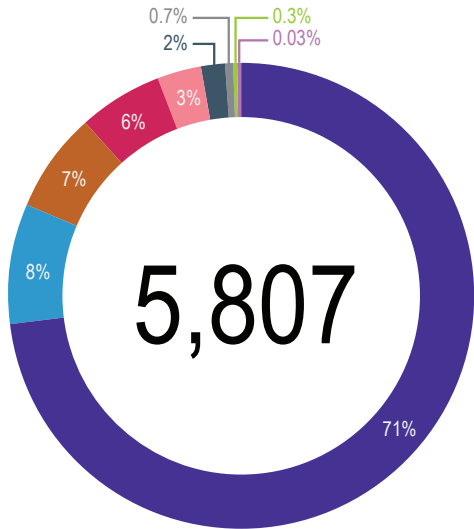
Adjuncts make up the largest bloc of faculty.



Of the 5,807 total faculty, 982 (16%) are full professors, 961 (17%) are associate professors, 888 (15%) are assistant professors, and 2,976 (51%) are adjuncts. The percentage distribution is identical to that of 2015–16.

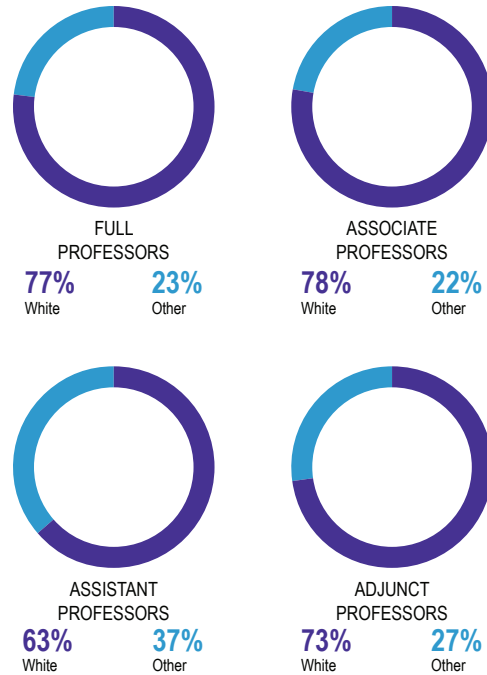

Of the 5,807 total faculty (including adjuncts), 4,245 (71%) indicated white for ethnicity. The remaining categories are as follows: 17 (0.3%) American Indian or Alaska Native; 408 (7%) Asian; 2 (0.03%) Native Hawaiian or other Pacific Islander; 181 (3%) Black or African American; 492 (8%) Hispanic; 43 (0.7%) two or more races; 90 (2%) nonresident alien; 329 (6%) race and ethnicity unknown.

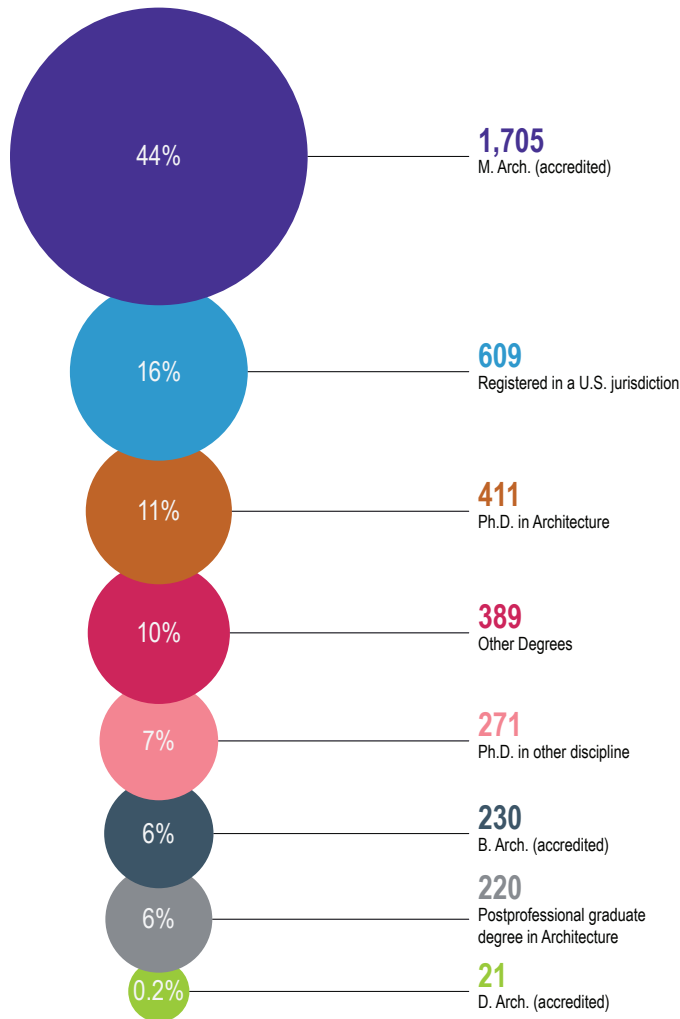

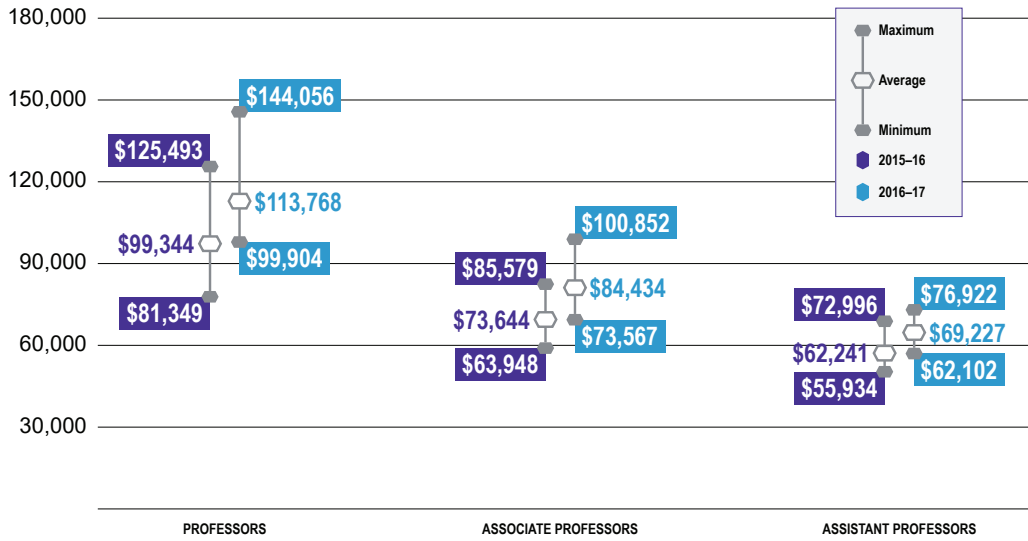
Credentials of Full-Time Faculty (does not include adjuncts)

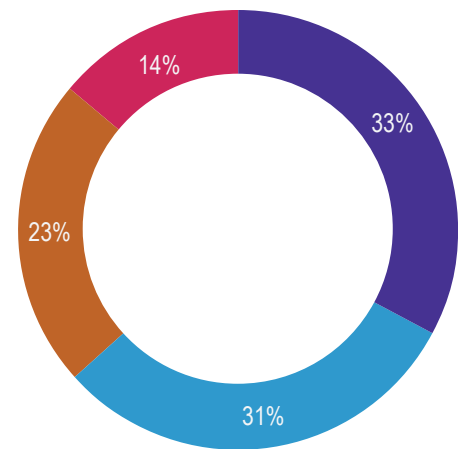
Characteristics of the NAAB Visiting Team Pool

Team Pool Composition by Collateral Organization



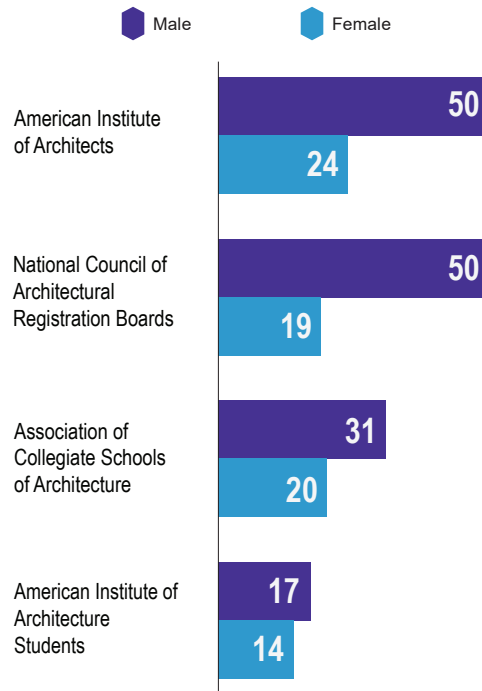
